What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data files sent to your computer by websites and stored in your web browser. These files do not transmit viruses or malware; their data remains static and cannot impact your computer's performance. Instead, cookies function like logs, tracking user activity and maintaining stateful information, updating each time you revisit a website.

We can gather information about you through cookies sent by our website. Various types of cookies monitor different activities. For instance, session cookies are active only while navigating a website and are deleted once you leave.

For this policy, money laundering is defined as activities intended to obscure or disguise the origins of illegally obtained money, making it appear as though it comes from legitimate sources or constitutes lawful assets.

Why are cookies useful?

We use functional cookies to understand how visitors interact with our website, enabling us to monitor and enhance its performance and functionality. Swiftly identifying and resolving issues helps us deliver a superior customer experience. Cookies allow us to find which pages are most popular and which navigation methods are most effective. Additionally, they help us track referrals from other websites, optimizing our future advertising campaigns.

Another purpose of cookies is to store your login sessions. For instance, when you log in to the Members Area to deposit funds, a "session cookie" is created. This cookie allows the website to remember that you are logged in, so you do not have to enter your login credentials on every new page as you proceed through the funding process. Without this cookie, you must repeatedly provide login information as you navigate the site.

Additionally, functional cookies help us remember your preferences and identify you as a user, ensuring that your information is secure and that the platform operates reliably and efficiently. For example, these cookies save you from having to enter your username each time you access our trading platform and help you remember your preferred settings, such as your chosen language, when logging in

- Verifying your identity and determining your current location
- Identifying your browser type and device
- Tracking the website you were referred from
- Enabling third parties to tailor content to your preferences

This website uses Google Analytics, a service from Google, Inc., to gather and analyze data on how users interact with the site. Google Analytics employs cookies on your computer to collect information, including your IP address. This data is then sent to Google's servers for processing. Google uses this information to understand website usage, generate reports on site activity, and provide additional related services. Analytical cookies

Analytical cookies provide data on visitor behavior patterns, which helps us improve the overall user experience and identify parts of the website that may need maintenance. This information is anonymous, meaning it cannot be used to identify you personally or access details such as your name or email address and is solely used for statistical analysis. Similarly, behavioral cookies track your visits to a website and use that data to deliver content tailored to your interests.

Promotional cookies

These cookies are employed to monitor user activity across different websites. Their purpose is to deliver more relevant and engaging advertisements for each user, increasing their value for publishers and third-party advertisers.

Preferences cookies

Preference cookies allow a website to retain information about your choices, such as your preferred language or region, which customizes the website's appearance and behavior to suit your preferences better.

Manage Cookies

Alternatively, you can turn off cookies, but be aware that this might affect our website's and other sites' functionality, potentially preventing you from signing in.
